



The Provost High School Summer Research Internship is a six-week program that begins in June and ends in August. This program is for high school students who are currently in 10th or 11th grade at the time of application, and are interested in science, engineering, and lab research.

During this six-week period, students work on research projects with their assigned professor and undergraduate and graduate student mentors.

This is a very competitive program with a limited number of positions. Your application package will be reviewed by the selection committee. If selected, your application package will be forwarded to a professor to see if he/she would be interested in working with you.

2024 Program Date and Duration

This is a six-week internship program that begins June 24, 2024, and ends August 1, 2024. This program does not count for high school credit.

REQUIRED FOR SELECTION: The student must commit themselves to attending every day of the program and for those hours during the entire six-week program. They are also required to attend all events highlighted below. **No exceptions will be made for any reason**. Any student who appears to have difficulty adhering to the time commitment will be asked to leave the program. (Exact days/hours are determined by the faculty member once selected.)

Eligibility

- Applicants must be completing 10th or 11th grade in June 2024. Graduating high school seniors are not eligible.
- Applicants should have an unweighted GPA of 3.75 or better, and show a demonstrated interest in science.
- Students must attend a New Jersey high school and be residents of New Jersey.
- Students must be able to commute to NJIT daily (at their own expense) for the duration of the program.
- A parent or legal guardian must grant permission for the student to participate in the program.

Application Process:

1. Complete application Google form

2. Essay (saved as YourLastName_essay and uploaded on google form) Limited to two total
pages. (This is uploaded to the Google form.)

3. Transcript - can typically be found on Genesis or similar school system. (uploaded to google
form)

4. If accepted, the program fee of \$500 and all permission forms are required by **May 1, 2024**. Instructions and forms will be sent in acceptance email.

*This fee is used for program costs. Accepted payment methods: credit or debit card. Please email hssri@njit.edu if you have financial hardships. Scholarships available to those who qualify.

All documents need to be received via google form before 4:30 PM on February 26, 2024, for consideration.
