

## **Mercury Spill Procedure for Undergraduate Students**

Mercury Vapors can be very hazardous to human health. In the event of a broken or cracked mercury-filled instrument, please adhere to following procedure:

1) Report any spill or broken lamp to lab supervisor or teaching assistant (TA) immediately; if no one is available, contact Public Safety at (9-1-1) or (973-596-3111).

NJIT EHS can also be contacted at (973-596-3059).

When placing a call to Public Safety or NJIT EHS, provide the operator with:

- a) Your name and phone extension.
- b) Exact location of spill (building and room number).
- c) Name of material spilled.
- d) Quantity of material spilled.
- e) Information on injuries to personnel or students
- 2) Evacuate all personnel and students from spill area. If spill is near exit or corridor, please be sure to evacuate all areas affected by spill.
- 3) Ventilate room area as much as possible by opening lab doors and windows.
- 4.) After spill clean-up is complete, please consult with you lab supervisor or TA prior to reentering the spill area.
- 5.) All incidents must be formally reported. Please report all spills, injuries, and laboratory emergencies to Public Safety (973-596-3111) and EHS (973-596-3059) to a draft an incident report on file.
